YOU ARE WELCOME TO ATTEND all of the 3 events that weekend and 2 of them are free to you. Friday night Meet-n-Greet will require a \$10 advance ticket or \$25 at the door. Saturday and Sunday events are free to you. Please make sure that you are somehow identified as a volunteer to avoid paying to attend. Remember you **DO REPRESENT** the Baja Blues Fest and do promise to act accordingly.
